Ahold shareholders adopt 2012 financial statements

Amsterdam, the Netherlands – Ahold today held its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders (AGM) at het Muziekgebouw aan 't IJ in Amsterdam. The meeting was attended by 345 shareholders, representing approximately 735 million votes.

Shareholders adopted Ahold's 2012 financial statements and determined the dividend over 2012 at €0.44 per common share, to be paid on May 2, 2013.

Shareholders also adopted all other proposals on the agenda, in particular:

- the appointment of mr. J.H.M. Hommen as member of the Supervisory Board, effective October 1, 2013;
- the reappointment of mr. D.C. Doijer to the Supervisory Board;
- the reappointment of mrs. S.M. Shern to the Supervisory Board;
- the reappointment of mr. B.J. Noteboom to the Supervisory Board;
- amendments to the Remuneration Policy for the Corporate Executive Board;
- amendments to the Remuneration for the Supervisory Board;
- amendments to the articles of association and;
- the appointment of PricewaterhouseCoopers Accountants N.V. as external auditor for financial year 2013.
